

ACCLIMATE

Acclimate has continued to grow in popularity over the years. When you block an animal's ability to smell, you will automatically disengage their fear mechanism. When their fear mechanism fails to function, they become more docile and rely upon whatever bond they have to another like mammal and/or human in order to survive! Acclimate has been utilized from the race track to the show ring or the pasture and all over the U.S. and Canada with resounding results for over 10 years!

Acclimate liquid is available in 32 oz spray bottles, 1 gallon and 2.5 gallon jugs and can be applied by two (2) methods;

Horses & Show Cattle:

1. Lightly spray on the nostrils and to the rump, 20 minutes prior to the integration into the group while the animals are all still calm.
2. You may be required to spray the Liquid Acclimate onto a clean towel in order to properly apply to the nasal area; common sense will be the rule.

Feeder Cattle, Hogs, Sheep and Goats:

1. Prior to unloading into the facility and/or pen, using a 2.5-gallon pump garden sprayer, adjust the spray nozzle to a light mist and spray the liquid Acclimate around the facility so that it begins to assume the new scent prior to population.
2. Using a 2.5-gallon pump garden sprayer, adjust the spray nozzle to a coarser spray and spray the animals from head to rump as the livestock begin to enter the facility from a truck as they are coming off the ramp.
3. As the group has begun to get assembled, adjust the spray nozzle over to a fine mist and begin to spray around the area reapplying the Liquid Acclimate to all the members of the new group.
4. The group should begin to settle within 45 minutes to an hour.
