When a new animal is introduced to an established group, they are identified as a stranger and the aggressive herd members will immediately go on the defensive in order to protect the submissive members in the group. ACCLIMATE naturally blocks an animal's ability to identify changes in smell and taste which allows introduction of new animals with reduced fighting. This scent- blocking characteristic makes it effective in reducing any scent-related misbehavior in a wide variety of situations. The Mini-Stick and Quick-Stick was designed for easy application that offers complete coverage of the nostril area of domesticated animals. The effects of ACCLIMATE will last up to 12 to 18 hours after one application. Uses include: introduction of new animals into a herd, loading and shipping animals, keeping aggressive males and/or females in close quarters, entering a show/sale ring, placing an orphan on a surrogate mother, breeding an aggressive stallion or mare, and prior to a visit from your vet or farrier. Acclimate livestock introduction formula is in a liquid format for the ease of application of non-domesticated animals. Works great on horses, beef and dairy cattle, hogs and sows, as with any other herbivore. The paste sticks will cover 10 to 30 head and the spray costs less than .10 cents per application.

Question's Frequently Asked

Q. Why should I use ACCLIMATE®?

A. To prevent an injury prior to exposing an animal to a stressful situation.

Q. When should I use ACCLIMATE®?

A. When ever an animal is subjected to a hazardous or unfamiliar situation.

Q. What animals will benefit from the use of ACCLIMATE®?

A. Acclimate® will have a positive effect on any herbivore or omnivore, ie: Horses, Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Hogs and Sows, Show/Hunting Dogs, Breeding Deer, Elk and Bison.

Q. How long will the effects of ACCLIMATE® last?

A. It depends on the particular species and the sensitivity of their olfactory sensory system, although, you can expect an average 8 to 12 hours.

Q. How does ACCLIMATE® work?

A. All herbivores and/or omnivorous survive from their keen sense of smell and taste. These same animals are usually extremely gregarious and/or group orientated. When these groups are established, each member acquires the same scent by way of consuming the same water, forage and other by-products. This is how the members within the group identify themselves; they all acquire the same smell. All herds are divided up into three groups: The Aggressive, The Homogenous and The Submissive. When an outsider enters into the established group, they are then identified as a stranger because they have a totally different scent. The aggressive herd members will immediately go into an defensive position in order to protect the submissive members within. ACCLIMATE® will naturally block an animals ability to negotiate distinct changes in smell and taste.

Q. How do I apply and use ACCLIMATE®?

A. ACCLIMATE® comes in the Mini Stick™ or the Quick Stick™ as well as the liquid version of the Original Formula. For best results, wipe the “Paste” Stick on to the nasal area of domesticated animals or spray the Original Formula™ on the nasal area as well as the back and rump area. It is very important to apply ACCLIMATE® to all of the animals that reside in the group/herd

Acclimate requires about 20 minutes to filly the olfactory sensory system and fully take effect!

Q. Give me a few examples where ACCLIMATE® can be used.

1. Prior to the introduction of new animals into an established herd
2. Prior to loading, during transport, as well as post arrival acclimation.
3. Will keep aggressive males and/or females from fighting when placed in extremely close quarters.
4. Use Acclimate® just prior to entering the show ring and/or chute, a sale ring or a totally new environment.
5. When placing an orphan on to its surrogate nurse mother.
